FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Michigan election law was substantially changed with the passage of Proposal 2018-3. These changes and other information, including whether you are registered to vote in Frankenmuth Township can be found at <https://www.michigan.gov/sos/0,4670,7-127-1633---,00.html>.

1. Where do I vote?

Frankenmuth Township only has one precinct. All voting takes place at the Public Safety Room in the Fire/Police Station next to City Hall.

2. How do I get an absentee ballot?

Email the Clerk at Clerk@frankenmuthwp.com or leave a message at 989-652-6741 x. 184 to have an Application to Vote Absentee mailed to you. Fill out the form, return it to the Clerk and an absentee ballot will be mailed to you. Return postage is the voter's responsibility. Ballots can be dropped off at the City receptionist desk between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

3. What if I lose my ballot?

Contact the Clerk to be issued another ballot.

4. When are polls open?

Polls open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day and close at 8:00 p.m. All absentee ballots must be received by 8:00 p.m. and can be hand-delivered to the polling station.

5. I have difficulty walking and I can't read very well but I want to vote in person. Can you help me?

The polling place is handicap accessible. Voting assistance is available either by our trained election inspectors or with a Voter Assist Terminal.
